PLEASE NOTE THAT IT IS THE CLIENT'S (HORSE OWNER, LESSEE OR CASUAL RIDER/HANDLER) RESPONSIBILITY TO ARRANGE PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE, BY DIRECTLY CONTACTING A SUITABLE INSURANCE BROKER.

A PUBLIC LIABILITY POLICY MUST BE IN PLACE BEFORE YOUR HORSE ENTERS THE CENTENNIAL PARKLANDS EQUESTRIAN CENTRE OR BEFORE A NEW LESSEE OR RIDER COMMENCES.

THE ATTACHED PROPOSAL FORMS ARE PROVIDED FOR YOUR CONVENIENCE ONLY.

COMPLETION AND RETURN OF ONE OR BOTH OF THE ENCLOSED PROPOSAL FORMS TO THE MANAGEMENT OF CENTENNIAL PARKLANDS EQUESTRIAN CENTRE WILL NOT CONSTITUTE AN INSURANCE POLICY.

PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

The Centennial Parklands Equestrian Centre and Grounds Code of Conduct and Regulations, requires all horse owners, lessees, part lessees, handlers trainers and other riders to provide the Centennial Park and Moore Park Trust with confirmation that they have in place Public Liability Insurance (cover to exceed \$2,000,000). Evidence of Insurance (current EFA Membership is acceptable) must be provided to the Trust via the Centre Manager before the horse arrives at either Centennial Parklands Equestrian Centre or Centennial Park Equestrian Grounds. **UNFORTUNATELY, HORSES THAT FAIL TO MEET THIS REQUIREMENT WILL NOT BE PERMITTED ENTRY AND RIDERS MAY BE.**

We confirm that there are two (2) options available to you:

Option 1 – Public Liability Insurance (Private Cover)

You will need to arrange insurance cover through an insurance broker or directly with an insurance company of good reputation. If you select Option 1, you will need to provide the CPEC Centre Manager with an Insurance Certificate of Currency or a Policy Schedule indicating the following information:-

1. Name of the insured person
2. Name of Insurance Company
3. Policy Number
4. Name of horse (insured)
5. Period of Insurance
6. Nominated rider/s
7. Amount of cover (to exceed \$2,000,000)
8. Location
9. Confirmation that the policy is fully paid

We provide the details of two (2) insurance brokers who we know to underwrite equine Public Liability Insurance with CGU Insurance:-

We have enclosed herein Insurances Proposal forms for both companies for your convenience. If you take up this option **YOU** must complete and return the proposal form to the nominated broker. **Completion and return of one or both of the enclosed proposal forms to the Management of Centennial Parklands Equestrian Centre will not constitute an insurance policy.**

Option 2 - EFA Membership

We confirm that under the Equestrian Federation of Australia's National Insurance Program all EFA members are automatically covered for \$10,000,000 Public & Products Liability as part of their membership. However, please note that where an EFA member has someone else riding or handling their horse, where that person is not an EFA member and your horse is found to cause bodily injury or property damage to any member of the public you **WILL NOT** be covered under the EFA policy. It is also worthwhile to note that there is a \$2500 excess on all claims made through the EFAs insurance policy.

If you choose Option 2, you will need to provide to the CPEC Centre Manager a copy of your current year's EFA Membership Card. EFS membership runs from July 01 to June 30 each year. In addition, we would ask that you acknowledge that you fully understand the conditions of the EFA Membership with respect to the exclusion of non EFA Members from this cover. Please indicate your acceptance by signing, dating and returning to the CPEC Centre Manager a copy of this letter, along with a copy of your EFA Membership Card.
